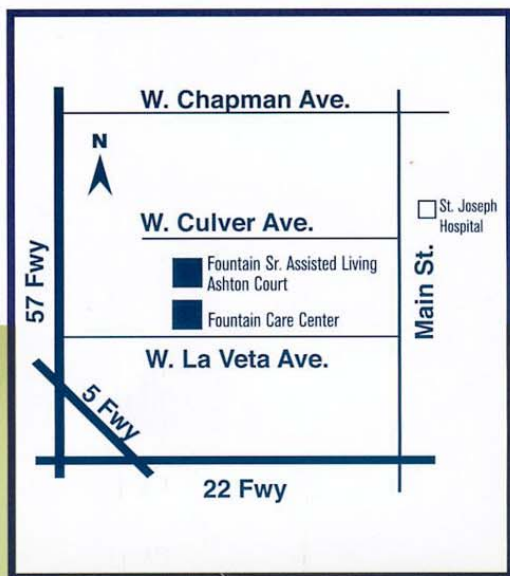

We accept Medicare, Medi-Cal, Worker's Compensation, private and managed care insurance health plans.

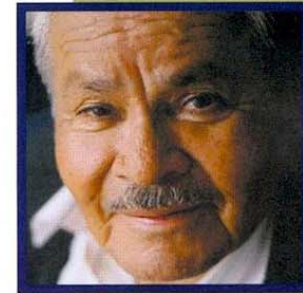
